General Area: Lassen County, public land, Lassen pack area

General situation and animal information: A cow carcass was discovered on June 18, and was investigated by USDA Wildlife Services the same day.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: There were teeth marks with associated hemorrhaging of the size and location on the carcass that were consistent with a wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Wolf tracks were found in the area.

Summary: The cow carcass had premortem wounds that indicated the cow was killed by wolves.
