

LIVESTOCK LOSS DETERMINATION

General Area: Eastern Siskiyou County, private timberland, Whaleback pack area

General situation and animal information: Siskiyou County personnel investigated wolf collar clustered locations and found carcasses of an adult cow and calf in a cattle pasture on private timberlands.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The calf carcass had teeth marks with associated hemorrhage the size and location consistent with wolf attack. There were no marks on the adult cow.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Wolf satellite collar locations and wolf tracks in vicinity of the carcass.

Summary: Evidence suggested that the calf may have been killed by wolves, and no evidence that the adult cow was killed by wolves could be found.
