**General situation and animal information**: A 300 lb. calf was discovered on September 10 and was investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

**Physical evidence of wolf predation:** The carcass had external bite marks with associated subcutaneous and musculature hemorrhage of the size and location indicative of wolf attack.

**Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury**: LAS32F's satellite collar locations were at the site early that morning, as well as wolf tracks present at the site.

**Summary**: Evidence indicated that the calf was killed by wolves.
