**General situation and animal information**: One dead and three injured lambs were discovered on the morning of January 2. USDA Wildlife Services investigated the next day.

**Physical evidence of wolf predation:** The carcass had external bite marks with associated subcutaneous and muscle hemorrhage. The injured animals had injuries consistent with a wolf attack.

**Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury**: LAS23F's satellite collar was detected at the location the evening before the discovery.

Summary: Evidence indicated that one lamb was killed, and three lambs were injured by wolves.
