General situation and animal information: On April 7, a cluster of locations from WHA05F's collar in a private pasture suggested a potential carcass. The property owner was notified, traveled to the site, and observed three wolves in the vicinity of a dead calf. USDA Wildlife Services investigated the carcass the same day.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of teeth marks with associated hemorrhage were indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: WHA05F's satellite collar was located in the general area the previous evening, and the three wolves were photographed and video recorded at the site.

Summary: All evidence indicated that the calf was killed by wolves.
