General situation and animal information: A dead cow was reported on October 3 and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of teeth marks with associated premortem hemorrhage were indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Wolf tracks within an area of disturbed ground (i.e., torn up grass) indicative of an attack scene were found near the carcass.

Summary: Evidence indicated the cow was killed by wolves.
