- Probable Wolf

General Area: Western Lassen County, private property, Harvey pack area

General situation and animal information: Two dead calves were reported on 18 March and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of premortem teeth marks on both calves was indicative of a wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Satellite collars for all five GPS-collared Harvey pack wolves were located in the area around the estimated time of death.

Summary: Evidence indicated the calves were killed by wolves.
