General situation and animal information: A dead calf was reported on 13 April and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of premortem teeth marks and associated premortem hemorrhaging was indicative of a wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Location data from a radio collared wolf in the area around the estimated time of death.

Summary: Evidence indicated the calf was killed by wolves.
