General situation and animal information: An injured calf was reported on 16 April and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services. During the investigation, the calf was euthanized.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of premortem teeth marks was indicative of a wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Location data for radio collared wolves place them in the area near the estimated time of death.

Summary: Evidence indicated the calf was injured by wolves.
