General situation and animal information: A dead calf was reported on May 19 and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of premortem teeth marks and associated hemorrhaging was indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Wolf tracks were found near carcass.

Summary: Evidence indicated the calf was killed by wolves.
