**General Area:** Central Tulare County, Tule River Tribe Reservation, Yowlumni pack area

**General situation and animal information:** A deceased heifer was found by Tule River Tribe Staff on June 5<sup>th</sup> and investigated the same day by CDFW staff.

**Physical evidence of wolf predation:** none, no subcutaneous hemorrhaging observed, no struggle/kill scene.

**Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury:** A single set of wolf tracks were observed near the scene. BEY03F collar data indicated presence near the scene on June 2 for less than four hours.

**Summary:** Advanced stages of scavenging prevented a thorough investigation. Bear and wild pig scat were observed at the carcass.
