DECLARATION ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I understand, this permit authorizes up to three daily bag and possession limits of saltwater fin fish, lobster, and rock scallop for a person fishing in ocean waters, during the multi-day trip designated above. No person may take more than one daily bag for a person fishing in ocean waters, during the multi-day trip designated above. No person may take more than one daily bag limit of fish per calendar day and the provisions of this permit **do not** apply to salmon, steelhead, striped bass, or sturgeon take and possession limits. The vessel cannot berth or dock within five miles of the mainland shore and all passengers must disembark at the return port stated above.

I further understand that if I am a CPFV fishing within 10 miles of the mainland shore of California I must provide a copy of the passenger manifest with this declaration.
